He was also presented in good full coat and trimmed to perfection. He moved well in the dog challenge driving from his short hocks around the ring. I was delighted to award him his 2nd **CC** today and wish him luck for the future. Unfortunately later he did not move so well in the BIS challenge conceding to the girls today.
